Information for Bidders and **Special Terms and Conditions**

SMRAA reserves the right to accept or reject all bids or option bids.

Bidder shall list any deviations from bid specifications (additions or deletions to requested equipment).

SMRAA reserves the right to cancel any agreements resulting from this bid for non-performance or failure of the SMRAA Board to approve sufficient funding as set forth below.

At the time of the bid opening, each bidder will be presumed to have read and be thoroughly familiar with the Bid Document (including all addenda) and to understand SMRAA's needs about the Grooming Equipment required for maintaining the recreational facility.

The successful Bidder shall be required to respond to all "Unit Down" Service requests within 4 hours of notification for those items covered under warranty. All warranty repairs must be completed in a timely manner.

Failure of the Bidder to complete the above duties shall in no way relieve the Bidder from any obligation in respect to their bid.

All questions regarding bid specifications should be directed to Mark Hoffman, director of mountain operations and maintenance, via email or phone using the address and numbers listed on page 12 of the bid document. Inquiries must be received at least three working days prior to the bid opening date.

General

These specifications intend to be described in sufficient detail to secure bids for 1 Hydrostatic Drive Alpine Snow Grooming Tractor. The Grooming Tractor must be the manufacturer's Current Design and must meet or exceed all specifications. The Tractor must be the manufacturer's model designed explicitly for terrain park construction and maintenance. The proposed Tractor may be either a new or a low-hour, prior-year Demonstrator vehicle. In the case of a Demonstrator, the Tractor's accumulated operating hours must not exceed 1,000, and the unit must be refurbished to repair any damage that it may have incurred as a demonstrator.

The Tractor must include a 12-way Blade and Flexible Power Tiller. The tractor must have Stick-type Electronic Digital Steering Controls. The Tractor must have an Electronic Engine Management System. The Tractor must be equipped with a Quick Attach Blade Mounting Mechanism to allow the operator to switch between front-mounted implements easily. All parts not explicitly mentioned that are necessary to provide a complete, standard-equipped Grooming Tractor must be included in the bid and supplied with the Tractor and must conform in strength, quality of material, and workmanship to what is typically provided by the industry in general.

Any proposal not conforming to these specifications as outlined in this invitation to bid will be rejected. The bidder must conform to the requirements of the bid unless deviations have been cited in the bid and acceptance by SMRAA made on that basis.

Any additions, deletions, or variations from the following specifications must be stated, and the reason for variations and deviations must be noted. These specifications shall be construed as a minimum. Specifications require that the bidder furnish descriptive literature, complete specifications, warranty information, and any other pertinent data on the equipment that they propose to provide.

Failure to complete all information on the questionnaire and bid request form may be cause for rejection of the bid.

All bids are subject to SMRAA Board approval.

As part of this bid, it will be necessary for the successful bidder to take in trade a 2018 PB 400 Park currently in SMRAA's possession. The details for that equipment can be found at the end of this Bid Document. This equipment is available for inspection by contacting Mark Hoffman, director of mountain operations and maintenance, as detailed on page 12.

Durability

The vehicle must be designed to achieve a five-year operating life of 6,000 hours without requiring a significant overhaul.

Parts and Service

Because maintaining this equipment in good operating condition without protracted downtime for repairs is essential, any repair parts must be available for delivery during regular business hours, and after-hours emergency parts and service must be available during the winter ski season. (November-May)
